## RUMBLE ON THE RIVER COLLECTOR'S ITEM

This is a very rare collector's item in a unique numbered series of 2500 pieces with a real piece of the original ring canvas which was used for the historical heavyweight title boxing fight of Lennox Lewis vs. Mike Tyson at The Pyramid Arena in Memphis, Tennessee, 8th June 2002. Each item will be delivered with a numbered certificate of origin belonging to this collector's item and carrying the same number.

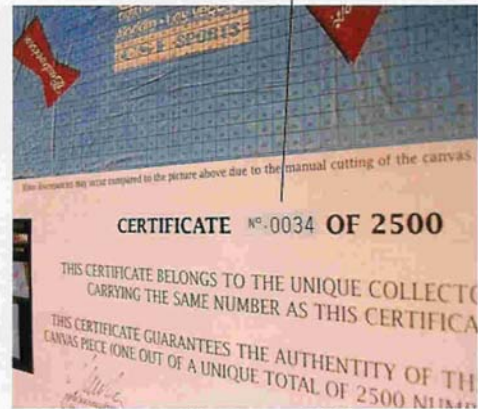
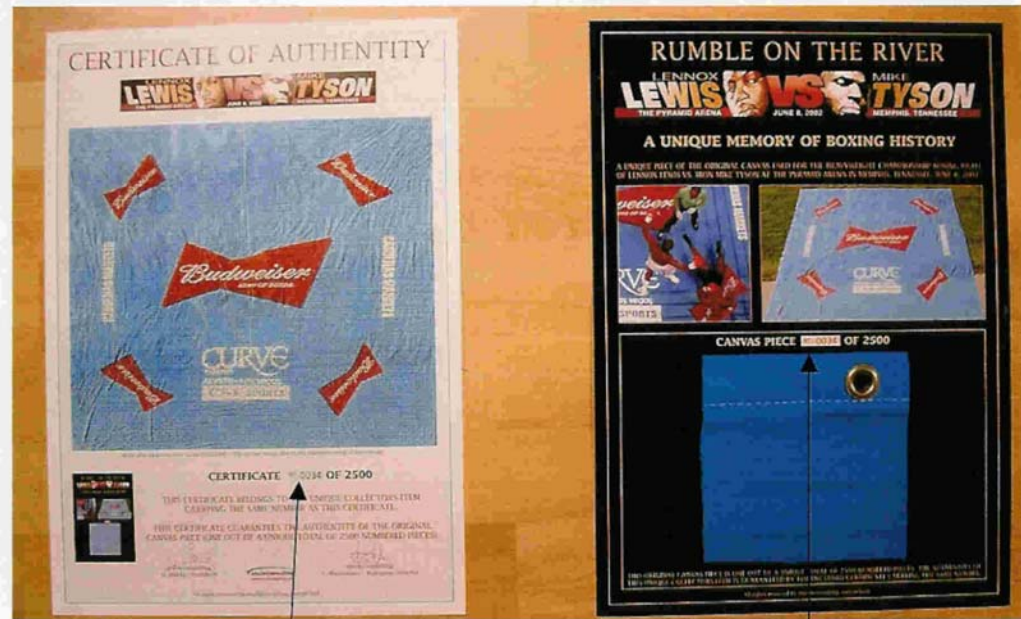

Each single canvas piece is different due to the manual cutting (\*can also differ in size). Some pieces have sewn, grommets, bloodstains (mainly Mike Tyson's blood), are plain blue, have parts of the advertisement prints or do have marks from the various people, who were standing on the canvas before, during and after this fight.

The certificate will identify the position on the canvas from which each single numbered piece has been cut off. It also certifies the authenticity of the piece respectively of the canvas. Due to the manual cutting of the canvas, minor discrepancies may occur with some pieces compared to their numbered position on the certificate.

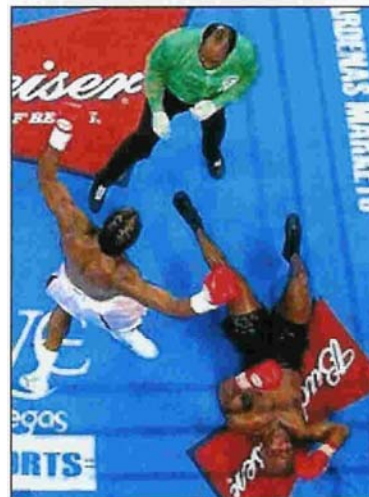


## Description

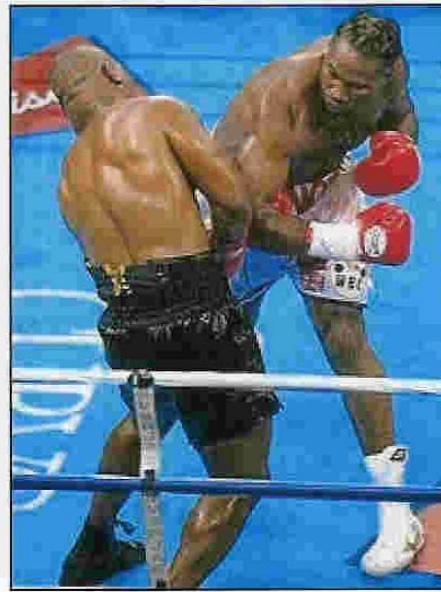
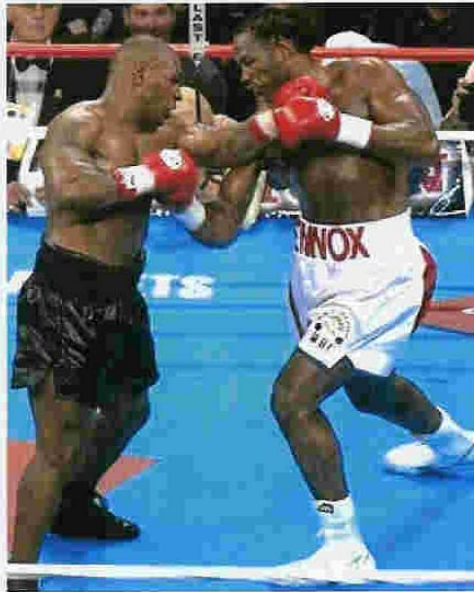

**DESCRIPTION**  
The sky blue cotton heavy duty canvas bearing sponsor logos, brass grommets to borders, blood stains, gold with a letter of provenance supplied by the vendor.

In a long-awaited fight, Lennox Lewis recorded a superb victory over 'Iron' Mike Tyson to retain his world heavyweight boxing crown in Memphis, 8th June 2002. Lewis produced his best form to see off the former champion & cement his reputation as one of the finest heavyweights of the modern era.

He finished the contest 2 minutes & 25 seconds into the 8th round with a crushing right hook that left Tyson flat on his back. Lewis had been on top throughout the contest & twice floored the challenger during the decisive 8th round, the earlier knock down delivered by a left upper cut.

Lennox Lewis's professional fight record (1989-2002) stands at 39 wins (30 by K.O.), 2 defeats & 1 draw. He first became World Champion in 1993 & was the first Briton to be crowned World Heavyweight Champion in the 20th century. As an amateur, Lewis won a boxing gold medal at the Seoul Olympics of 1988.
