# RUMBLE ON THE RIVER COLLECTOR'S ITEM

This is a very rare collector's item in a unique numbered series of 2500 pieces with a real piece of the original ring canvas which was used for the historical heavyweight title boxing fight of Lennox Levis vs. Mike Tyson at The Pyramid Arena in Memphis, Tennessee, 8th June 2002. Each item will be delivered with a numbered certificate of origin belonging to this collector's item and carrying the same number.

Each single canvas piece is different due to the manual cutting (\*can also differ in size). Some pieces have sewn, grommets, bloodstains (mainly Mike Tyson's blood), are plain blue, have parts of the advertisement prints or do have marks from the various people, who were standing on the canvas before, during and after this fight.

The certificate will identify the position on the canvas from which each single numbered piece has been cut off. It also certifies the authenticity of the piece respectively of the canvas. Due to the manual cutting of the canvas, minor discrepancies may occur with some pieces compared to their numbered position on the certificate.

There are also other marks from the various people who were standing on this canvas before, during and after this fight. This original canvas has been bought by stuckiconsulting Switzerland.






